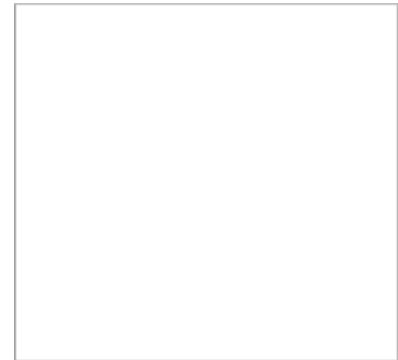

- HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATES WHO ARE WORKING MUST HAVE A PARENT SIGNATURE AND PRESENT A PHOTO ID

DANCE RULES

1. All school rules are in effect, whether the dance is on school property or not
2. This dance will be held IN the Padua Gym. Check-in will take place in BOTH lobbies and you will proceed to the gym after check-in.
3. Once a student or guest leaves the dance, they are not allowed to return. NO MONEY WILL BE REFUNDED
4. Any student or guest who is in possession of alcohol or drugs, or is found to have used such substances before attending the dance will be held by the police until their parents can pick them up. All students or guests may be subject to an on-site breathalyzer test. If the test proves positive, the Parma Police have the option of arresting offending students or guests.
5. Students are responsible for the behavior of their OUTSIDE guests, especially those who cannot provide valid ID.
6. Students and guests may not bring containers such as water, pop or sports drink bottles into the dance.
7. Dancing should reflect proper modesty. Sexually suggestive styles of dancing such as grinding, or backside to front side dancing will not be permitted (partners must face each other while dancing). Additionally, break-dancing, moshing and similar styles of dancing that encourage pushing, excessive jumping, throwing and physical force are not permitted.
8. Students who do not comply with these rules or the directives of dance moderators will be subject to disciplinary action, including detentions and/or removal from the dance. Padua students are responsible for the conduct of their guests.
9. The dress code for this dance is semi-formal to formal
10. All outside guests must be in 9th grade or above, but must not be over 20 years old.
11. All students and guests attending the dance must check in upon arrival. Parents will be called if a student arrives at the school after 8:00 PM or leaves before 9:00 PM.

Students or guests who do not comply with these rules or the directives of dance moderators will be removed from the dance and will be subject to further disciplinary action.
