## CFO COLLECTIONS

(will take place in the Lobby from 11/28-12/15)

**The Mitten Tree** – Padua’s official Christmas tree, sponsored by the Robotics Club. Place new mittens, hats, or scarves on the tree. Donations will be given to the West Side Catholic Center.

**Toy Collection**– Sponsored by NHS. *New toys* are requested for this venerable charitable effort. All donations will be given to the Bishop Cosgrove Center.

**The St. Francis of Assisi Animal Care Project** – Sponsored by the Junior Class. The donation wish list includes the following items: paper towels, toilet paper, disinfectant bleach, no scent fabric softener, Fancy Feast Classic canned cat food, Friskies Pate canned cat food, Kongs (toy) for dogs, Soft and Chewy Milkbone treats (any flavor), and dishwashing liquid. All donations will be given to the Parma Animal Shelter.

**The Great Coat Cover-Up** – The Student Leadership Core will be collecting new and (clean) used coats to help those in Northeast Ohio.

**Santa’s Sock Collection**- The Sophomore Class will help meet the growing needs of homeless men, women and children in the Greater Cleveland area by collecting socks, the item most requested by those who live out in the elements. Socks will go to the Community West Foundation and their SocksPLUS Initiative.

**Blankets for Babies and Others** – Sponsored by the Freshman Class, a drive for new and (clean) used blankets and sleeping bags for the needy and homeless. Baby blankets will be given to Birthcare of Medina and adult blankets will go to Catholic Worker House in Cleveland.

**Food Bins** – Sponsored by Campus Ministry and Theology classes. Bring in canned or non-perishable foods for the collection bins. Donations will be given to various food banks in the Parma and Greater Cleveland area.

**Promise for Haiti Collection**- Sponsored by MedTrack. MedTrack students will be collecting toothbrushes, toothpaste, floss, and soap (non-liquid) for all ages. Donations will be given to the Promise for Haiti Dental Clinic.

**Babies in Need**- Sponsored by the Senior Class. Seniors will be collecting diapers, baby wipes, toddler size clothes, children's books, and baby washes/ lotions. Donations will be given to Birthcare of Medina County.

**Book Collection** - Sponsored by the Environmental Club & Creative Writing Club. The Environmental Club & Creative Writing Club will be collecting new and gently-used children's books. Age appropriate themes, along with the need for books that show diversity, are encouraged. Donations will be given to the Kid's Book Bank which provides free books to children in the Greater Cleveland area.

**CFO Kickoff (11/28 Monday): (check-in)** Christmas for Others is back! Join us for a special afternoon rally to find out what this CFO season has in store. This is the most important campaign we do all year. Find out why it is so important to our Padua community.

**Advent Lessons & Carols (Tuesday 11/29: 7 PM ): (check-in)** Joint event with Performing Arts at St. Anthony of Padua Church. An evening of prayer and song to celebrate the Advent season.

**Nachos for Niños (Wednesday 11/30 and Friday 12/2)**– Spanish Club invites you to enjoy nachos and cheese for the low price of \$2, available during all lunch periods! Feliz Navidad!

**Chocolate para Chicos (Tuesday 11/29- 12-16):** Feliz Navidad! The Spanish Club will be selling chocolate bars throughout the CFO season. See Mrs. Kinzie in room 124 to buy yours, the cost is \$1.

**Coin Wars (Wednesday 11/30 thru Tuesday 12/6): (check-in)** Hosted by the Senior Class. Each class and the faculty/staff have their own jar in the G.O. The class jar with the most net change wins – paper money/checks deduct from the value of the coin total in the jar. The final day of Coin Wars will be celebrated with a morning assembly on 12/6. You'll want to bring loose change to this assembly! If the entire school collects more than \$6,000 total, then everyone will be awarded a dress-down day!
