### Payment Policy 2023-2024

The enrollment form and payment must be completed before any student will be placed on the finalized lesson schedule or band/orchestra roster. *Music lessons and/or ensemble participation will be suspended if payment is not received by the payment dates listed below.*

#### **ENSEMBLE FEE:**

**ALL** students in the Elementary Instrumental Music Program will pay an *Ensemble Fee* which assists with costs for music, additional rehearsals, concert dinners, awards, etc. for the school year. **Adjustments:** If a student is enrolled in two ensembles, the student would pay the fee for both ensembles. Families with multiple students enrolled in music ensembles pay a maximum of \$100 of ensemble fees for the year.

Payment is due in advance as follows:

- One full payment for the year
  - o 7th and 8th GRADE BAND/ORCHESTRA \$50.00 by **Friday, September 22, 2023**
  - o 4th, 5th and 6th GRADE BAND/ ORCHESTRA \$25.00 by **Friday, September 22, 2023**

#### **MUSIC LESSON TUITION:**

*Music Lesson Tuition* for the school year is \$260.00 for a full year of lessons on one instrument. This tuition covers the cost for lessons *during the school day*. Students enrolled in additional instrument lessons during the school day must pay additional tuition (ie, a student takes violin *and* clarinet lessons during school each week pays two lesson tuitions).

Payment options are due in advance as follows:

- One full payment for the year (receive \$10 discount)
  - o \$250.00 by **Friday, September 22, 2023**
- Two semester payments (full price)
  - o \$130.00 by **Friday, September 22, 2023**
  - o \$130.00 by **Friday, January 19, 2024**

Please note that tuition rates take into account that both student and/or instructor may miss a small number of days due to illness, weather, field trips, etc. These absences are factored into the tuition. *Students are otherwise responsible to attend lessons while coordinating any missed class work with their teachers.* That said, no refunds/credits will be given, so please be sure your child is fully committing to the music program, including practicing at home.

Each student in grades 4-6 will be placed in either a 30-minute group lesson during the school day with students of similar skill levels or a 20 minute private lesson. Please pay for lesson tuition. Exception-if student is already taking private lessons outside of school.

Students in grades 7-8 are ENCOURAGED to take lessons outside of the school day with private instructors who specialize on a specific instrument. *Please consult the director for suggestions.* Do not pay lesson tuition if taking outside lessons.

Students in grades 7-8 who wish to continue lessons during the school day will either be scheduled with the main director or a private teacher who specializes in a specific instrument family (if available). Students at this level may be assigned private 20-minute lesson or 30-minute small group lesson. Please pay for lesson tuition.
