CFO COLLECTIONS- will take place in the Lobby from 11/27-12/19

<u>The Mitten Tree-</u> Padua's official Christmas tree, sponsored by the Robotics Club. Place new mittens, hats, or scarves on the tree. Donations will be given to the West Side Catholic Center.

Toy Collection- Sponsored by NHS. *New toys* are requested for this venerable charitable effort. All donations will be given to the Bishop Cosgrove Center.

<u>The St. Francis of Assisi Animal Care Project-</u>Sponsored by the Junior Class. The donation wish list includes the following items: dog and/or cat food, treats, toys, or kitty litter. All donations will be given to the Parma Animal Shelter.

<u>The Great Coat Cover-Up-</u> The Student Leadership Core will be collecting new and gently used clean coats to help those in Northeast Ohio.

<u>Santa's Sock Collection-</u> The Sophomore Class will help meet the growing needs of homeless men, women and children in the Greater Cleveland area by collecting socks, the item most requested by those who live out in the elements. Socks will go to the NEOCH and their SocksPLUS Initiative.

<u>Food Bins-</u> Sponsored by Campus Ministry and Theology classes. Bring in canned or non-perishable foods for the collection bins. Donations will be given to various food banks in the Parma and Greater Cleveland area.

<u>CFO Kickoff (11/27 Monday): (app check-in)</u> Christmas for Others is back! Join us for a special assembly to find out what CFO is all about and why it is so important to our Padua community.

CFO VIP Pass (All Mondays during CFO- 11/27, 12/4, 12/11, 12/18): Sponsored by Key Club. For the flat rate of \$15, you can enjoy your CFO Mondays much more comfortably. The CFO VIP Pass will be available for purchase during lunch periods from 11/13-11/17. **No Pass = No dress down!!** Passes will be personalized and signed by an administrator, and you will need to be prepared to have it on hand during the school day. All proceeds will go directly to CFO. This is your chance to donate AND dress down, so be sure to purchase a pass! Prefer to get both the V.I.P. pass and the t-shirt ? No problem! We can bundle both CFO items for a flat fee of \$20. (a savings of \$10!)

<u>Coin Wars (Tuesday 11/28 thru Tuesday 12/5): (app check-in)</u> Hosted by the Senior Class. Each class and the faculty/staff have their own jar in the G.O. The class jar with the most <u>net</u> change wins – paper money/checks deduct from the value of the coin total in the jar. The final day of Coin Wars will be celebrated with a morning assembly on 12/5. You'll want to bring loose change to this assembly!
